Afternoon,

I am the Traffic Management Officer for the Norfolk Constabulary and I have been forwarded your email from our designing out crime team

Having looked at your plans I have noted the following:-

Issues that have been raised to me from Police officers regarding the current section of the NDR (A1270) is that there is an insufficient number of lay-bys and places for the police to observe traffic/ conduct stop checks

It would be ideal if there could be a lay-by added in each direction along with a pair of observation platforms (raised locations for Police vehicles to observe the traffic) or if laybys cannot be added to the design a pair of observation platforms would be beneficial in maintaining road safety

Also the current NDR has had a number of collisions on the roundabouts during the hours of darkness. Consideration should therefore be given to sufficient lighting and or signage to prevent this occurring on this section on the new section of road

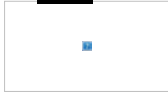
