### Norwich Western Link – Pre-planning Application Public Consultation Attlebridge Traffic Mitigation

Between 15 August 2022 and 9 October 2022 Norfolk County Council carried out a preplanning application consultation for the Norwich Western Link, which is a new 3.9 mile dual carriageway road proposed between the western end of Broadland Northway and the A47. The purpose of this consultation was to gather information that would help inform the development of the scheme before we submit a planning application next year.

The consultation included traffic mitigation proposals on the existing road network, which would be delivered as part of the Norwich Western Link to reduce traffic through Attlebridge, by prohibiting the right turn into Station Road from Reepham Road, and is shown on the map accompanying this letter.

Having considered the comments that were made about this proposal during the consultation the County Council is now proposing an alternative to the prohibited right turn. This alternative consists of a prohibition of motor vehicles on Station Road, Felthorpe Road and part of Old Fakenham Road as shown on the attached map. There will be an "except for access" exemption for vehicles accessing areas within the length of the restriction, so people travelling to and from this area would be unaffected but through traffic would be prohibited.

This restriction would be identified by the use of the appropriate traffic signs on site, with no physical closure of the roads being proposed. We are also proposing to revoke the current weight restrictions on Station Road and Felthorpe Road as through traffic would no longer be able to use these routes.

A separate map, which is also attached to this letter, provides details of the future year predicted traffic flows on local roads as a result of the alternative proposal. The "OY with NWL & Measures" figures shown include the traffic mitigation measures previously consulted upon during the pre-application consultation between 15 August and 9 October 2022. The only difference is that the originally proposed prohibited right turn from Reepham Road into Station Road has been removed and replaced with;

- (1) The revocation of the weight restrictions on Station Road and Felthorpe Road;
- (2) A prohibition of motor vehicles (except for access) restriction on Station Road, Felthorpe Road and Old Fakenham Road (as shown on the accompanying map).

The forecast traffic flows are shown for 2026.

The County Council is now carrying out a localised consultation on the alternative proposal for Attlebridge, and as a result we are writing to seek any comments you may have regarding this.




