### NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE) (ENGLAND) ORDER 2015 NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMISSION

**Proposed development (referred to as the Norwich Western Link)** at The Proposed Scheme covers an area of land approximately 287 hectares (ha) and is located approximately 10.5 kilometres to the north-west of the city of Norwich. The Proposed Scheme will connect the A1270 Broadland Northway from its junction with the A1067 Fakenham Road to the A47 trunk road near Honingham. The nearest settlements to the Proposed Scheme include, Weston Longville (approximately 0.2 kilometres to the west), Weston Green (approximately 0.27 kilometres to the north west), Honingham (approximately 0.1 kilometres to the south), Ringland (approximately 0.2 kilometres to the south), Attlebridge (approximately 0.3 kilometres to the north), and Easton (approximately 3.5 kilometres to the south of the Proposed Scheme alignment).

**I give notice that Norfolk County Council is applying to the Norfolk County Council for planning permission for:** Development of approximately 6 kilometres of the Norwich Western Link Road connecting the A1067 (Fakenham Road) with the new A47 North Tuddenham to Easton scheme (being developed by National Highways), including the construction of a new roundabout junction with the A1067 Fakenham Road, improvements to the A1067 Fakenham Road and the roundabout junction with the A1270 Broadland Northway. Structures include a new viaduct carrying the Norwich Western Link over the River Wensum, a new bridge over Ringland Lane, the provision of a green bridge carrying the Broadway over the Norwich Western Link, three further green bridges, wildlife mitigation, diversion and protection of apparatus and temporary works to facilitate construction, other ancillary works, and the change of use of the premises known as Low Farm to offices (use class E).

### THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL COLNEY, C182 HETHERSETT LANE FOOTWAY CONVERSION TO CYCLEWAY/FOOTWAY NOTICE 2024

### THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ASHBY ST MARY, HOLVERSTON, ROCKLAND ST MARY WITH HELLINGTON, THURTON) A146 NORWICH/LODDON ROAD) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) AMENDMENT ORDER 2024

The Norfolk County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 50 miles per hour along the length of the A146 Norwich Road/Loddon Road from a point 1230 metres north-west of the centre line of the C383 Ashby Road north-westwards to a point 205 metres north-west of the centreline of the C376 Mill Road. This would be an extension of the current 50mph speed restriction in this area by 1360m. The Norfolk County Council (Thurton) Speed Limits) Order 1998 (the 1998 Order) will be amended accordingly and include all references to this road for clarity and efficient administration of the restriction.
